NEW TO INVESTING IN THE SECURITIES MARKET?

MUTUAL

Here are 4 basic things you need to know:

- The TTSEC is the regulator for the securities industry in Trinidad and Tobago. This means that the TTSEC has direct oversight of all activity within this industry. The TTSEC is one of the four <u>core institutions that make up the financial landscape in</u> Trinidad and Tobago.
- 2) The types of securities regulated by the TTSEC in Trinidad and Tobago are stocks, bonds and mutual funds.
- 3) The TTSEC lists all companies (Reporting Issuers), broker-dealers, investment advisers and Underwriters (market intermediaries) registered to conduct business on its website, www.ttsec.org.tt. A list of all securities/investments are also listed on this website. You should check with the TTSEC first to ensure that both the product and the investment provider are registered.
- 4) Do your own research. Do not invest in any organisation, product or service, if you don't know about it. Consult with a registered investment adviser before you decide to invest.


