What is Wealth?

- Learning is the beginning of wealth and 'an investment in knowledge pays the best interest' –Benjamin Franklin
- Accumulation of Resources
- Measured over time and by purchasing power
- Maintained by ability of net-worth to keep ahead of inflation





How is Wealth Created?

- Acknowledge the place of saving in accumulation of fund
- Investment and the returns on investment
- Forms of investments ranging from real estate, directly or indirectly in businesses
- Investing in shares/equities powerful medium for good returns

- Junior Market Index average annual growth rate 78.96%
